Clark County's New Voting Process Explained

Clark County voters will notice a new step to the in-person voting process starting in 2026. The check-in process and voting machines (now called **ballot marking devices**) will remain the same as in recent elections. But now, once a voter makes their selections, they get a **printout of their ballot** to review before submitting it through the new **tabulators**.


Here's a break-down of the new voting process:



STEP 1

1

An election worker will confirm your information and issue you a vote card. Take the vote card to the ballot marking device.



STEP 2

2

Use the touchscreen to make your selections. The machine will then print your choices on a paper ballot, giving you the chance to review your selections before moving to the next step.



STEP 3

3

Take your printed ballot and vote card to the tabulator. Hand the vote card to an election worker and insert your paper ballot into the tabulator. This is the moment your vote is officially cast.

ATTENTION VOTERS

Important Information... Please Read Carefully

Three sample ballots are printed in your booklet. If you are registered as Democratic, refer to the sample ballot printed on a blue background. If you are registered as Republican, refer to the sample ballot printed on a yellow background. If you are not registered as either Democratic or Republican, refer to the Nonpartisan sample ballot printed on a white background. ***The party in which you registered is printed on the back cover of this sample ballot in the address block.*** If your party is not Democratic (DEM) or Republican (REP), Nonpartisan (NP) is indicated.

The sample ballot lists all the contests and questions for which you are eligible to vote in the order they will appear on the touch screen voting machine. The first contest is listed at the top of the left column. When you reach the bottom, proceed to the top of the next column, and so on.

If You Are Registered as Democratic:

- Your precinct's sample ballot is printed on pages 26 and 27 on a blue background.
- You may also vote for your precinct's nonpartisan contests and ballot questions (if any) printed on pages 30 and 31 on a white background.

If You Are Registered as Republican:

- Your precinct's sample ballot is printed on pages 28 and 29 on a yellow background.
- You may also vote for your precinct's nonpartisan contests and ballot questions (if any) printed on pages 30 and 31 on a white background.

If You Are Not Registered as Either Democratic or Republican:

- Your precinct's sample ballot and ballot questions (if any) are printed on pages 30 and 31 on a white background.

NOTE: Nevada is a Closed Primary State. In Nevada, voters are prohibited from voting for candidates from another party. Only registered Democratic voters may vote in the contests that decide which Democratic candidates advance to the General Election. Only registered Republican voters may vote in the contests that decide which Republican candidates advance to the General Election. All registered voters may vote in the nonpartisan contests that decide which of those candidates advance to the General Election. (NRS 293.257)

NOTICES

Assistance is Available at all Voting Sites: Ask any election worker for assistance if you need help reading the ballot or operating the voting machine. Reasonable accommodations will be made to help any voter requesting assistance at a voting site. (This notice is required by NRS 293.565.)

For Voters with Special Needs: Every voting site has a voting machine that can display the ballot in extra large font, provide audio voting, and support “sip and puff” technology.

ADA EASE: Nevada residents with a disability can mark their ballot electronically by going to **www.NVEASE.gov**. The Nevada’s Effective Absentee System for Election (EASE) is an online application that seamlessly integrates voter registration, electronic ballot delivery, and marking. EASE allows further independence and enables registered voters with a disability to register, request, mark, and return their ballots from the comfort of their own homes. EASE is available for elections no less than 46 days before Election Day at **www.NVEASE.gov**. If you have any questions regarding this voting method, please contact the Secretary of State of Nevada, Elections Office at (775) 684-5705.

You May Be Asked for Identification at the Voting Site: If the information you provided on your voter registration application did not match the information on file at the Department of Motor Vehicles or the Social Security Administration, as applicable, and you did not respond to the letter that was sent to you notifying you of the discrepancy, you will be required to provide identification when you vote. If you do not provide identification, you will only be allowed to vote provisionally. The words “ID Required” on the address label of your sample ballot indicate you will be required to provide identification at the time you vote.

“None of These Candidates”: In all statewide contests, you have the option to select “None of these candidates.” You may only select “None of these candidates” if you do not vote for any candidate for the office. (This notice is required by NRS 293.269(3).)

No Write-in Candidates: Nevada law (NRS 293.270) does not permit write-in candidates.

Candidate Party Abbreviations: Democratic Party-DEM, Republican Party-REP, Nonpartisan-NP.

WARNING

Voting More than Once in the Same Election is a Crime

A person shall not vote or attempt to vote more than once in the same election. Any person who votes or attempts to vote twice in the same election is guilty of a category D felony and shall be punished as provided in NRS 193.130. *(Publication of this warning is required by NRS 293.780)*

UPDATING YOUR REGISTRATION

You can update your voter registration information online if you have a Nevada driver's license or Nevada DMV-issued identification (ID). Simply go to **RegistertoVote.NV.gov** and update your address if you no longer reside at the address at which you registered or wish to change your political party. Eligible citizens who are not registered may also register online if they have a Nevada driver's license or Nevada DMV-issued ID.

LANGUAGE INFORMATION

In October 2021, Clark County was notified by the Civil Rights Division of the U.S. Department of Justice that in accordance with Section 203 of the Voting Rights Act, all future elections in Clark County must continue to be conducted in English, Filipino, and Spanish. ELECTRONIC SAMPLE BALLOTS

You may receive your sample ballot by e-mail instead of through the regular mail. Per Nevada law, your e-mail address will be kept CONFIDENTIAL and it may not be given to third parties. Sign-up today through **www.ClarkCountyNV.gov/vote**.

MAIL BALLOT VOTING

All Active Registered Voters Will Be Sent a Mail Ballot: The Election Department will send all active voters a mail ballot for the June 9, 2026, Primary Election (unless they have opted out of mail ballot voting 60 days or more before Election Day). If you do not receive your mail ballot packet by May 22, 2026, and wish to vote by mail, immediately contact us at: **(702) 455-VOTE (8683)**; or **MailBallotRequest@ClarkCountyNV.gov**.

IMPORTANT - As Soon as Possible, Return Your Voted Ballot In Your Signed Election Department Mail Ballot Return Envelope: Do not wait until the last minute to return your voted mail ballot. Mail it as soon as possible or deposit it at one of the convenient Election Department drop-off locations.

Mail Ballot Postmark and Receiving Deadlines for the June 9, 2026, Primary Election:

- Voted mail ballots must be returned in your postage-paid mail ballot return envelope provided by the Election Department, which you must also sign; and
- Postmarked on or before Tuesday, June 9, 2026; and
- Return envelopes postmarked on or before June 9, 2026, must be received by the Election Department no later than 5pm on the fourth day following Election Day.

Mail Ballot Drop-Off Locations: The full listing of mail ballot drop-off locations from Saturday, May 16, to Tuesday, Election Day, June 9, 2026, will be in your mail ballot packet, in your sample ballot, and at **www.ClarkCountyNV.gov/vote**. Dates and hours vary by location. You may drop off your voted mail ballot (inside your signed Election Department mail ballot return envelope) at any of the specified locations you choose during the indicated dates and times.

- Some government offices will also serve as mail ballot drop-off locations from May 16 to June 9, 2026.
- All Early Voting sites will also serve as mail ballot drop-off locations from May 23 to June 5, 2026.
- All Election Day Vote Centers will also serve as mail ballot drop-off locations on Tuesday, June 9, 2026.

Assisting Another Voter: If you assist another voter who is unable to sign the mail ballot return envelope or mark their own ballot, you must complete the Assistance Section on the envelope and provide your name, address, and signature, as required by law.

TIPS FOR MAIL BALLOT VOTING

This section is required only if a voter is assisted. A voter may be assisted at the voter's direction only if the voter 1) has a physical disability, 2) is 65+ years of age, or 3) is unable to read or write. If you mark the ballot and sign the ballot envelope for the voter, you must indicate this next to your signature that you acted on the voter's behalf. If you assist the voter in marking the ballot and signing the ballot envelope, the name, address, and signature of either the voter or the person assisting must be provided.



Don't Lose Your Vote!



Only Use the Election Department's Mail Ballot Return Envelope: If you lose or damage your Election Department mail ballot return envelope with your pre-printed name and address (included in your mail ballot packet) and you want to vote by mail, IMMEDIATELY call **(702) 455-VOTE (8683)** for replacement envelope information. Envelopes will also be available at all Early Voting sites and Election Day Vote Centers.

Sign the Outside of Your Envelope: Whether you mail or drop off your voted ballot, you must sign the outside of your Election Department mail ballot return envelope in the space provided. Failure to do this will result in a county election official contacting you for additional information. **IMPORTANT: Your signature will be checked against what is in the voter registration records.**

Only Place Your Own Ballot in Your Own Envelope: Do not put anyone else's ballot in your Election Department mail ballot return envelope. If it contains more ballots than your own, then you risk none of the ballots being counted.

Clearly Mark Your Ballot Per the Instructions: Follow the instructions in your mail ballot packet to clearly mark your choices with black or blue ink and ensure your ballot is counted.

- Avoid stray marks and tearing the ballot.
- Do not put the "I Voted" sticker on your ballot.
- Do not sign the ballot itself.
- To correct a mistake, follow the instructions in your mail ballot packet. Do not draw an "X" over a candidate's name or ballot question choice.

Secrecy Sleeve: A secrecy sleeve is included in your packet for you to place your voted mail ballot inside of it before putting it inside your Election Department mail ballot return envelope. However, the secrecy sleeve is not required. Your voted mail ballot will not be rejected simply because you did not include the secrecy sleeve.

IMPORTANT DATES FOR THE 2026 PRIMARY ELECTION

May 12, Tue.: Deadline for Standard Registration/Updates

The fourth Tuesday before Election Day is the last day to register to vote or to update your existing registration for the Primary Election without having to do so on the Secretary of State's website or through same-day registration.

May 13-26, Wed.-Tue.: Online Only Extended Registration/Updates (14 Days)

During this time, you may register to vote or update your existing registration ONLY online on the Nevada Secretary of State's website, **RegistertoVote.NV.gov**.

May 20, Wed.: Last Day to Automatically Receive a Sample Ballot

If you register to vote or update your existing registration after this date (less than 20 days before the current election), a sample ballot will not automatically be mailed to you for the current election.

May 23-June 5, Sat.-Fri.: Early Voting, Same-Day Registration/Updates (14 Days)

Any voter registered in Clark County, including those who wish to vote in person instead of by mail, may vote at any Early Voting site within this County. In-person same-day voter registration and updates of existing registration will be offered. New in-person registrants may only vote a provisional ballot. All Early Voting sites also will serve as mail ballot drop-off locations during voting hours. Dates and hours vary.

May 27-June 9, Wed.-Tue.: Online Same-Day Registration/Updates (14 Days)

At this time, you may register to vote or update your existing registration online on the Nevada Secretary of State's website, **RegistertoVote.NV.gov**. You may NOT vote by mail. You may only vote in person at any Early Voting site or Election Day Vote Center you choose within this County. New online registrants during this time period may only vote a provisional ballot.

JUNE 9, TUE., 7AM-7PM: PRIMARY ELECTION DAY, Same-Day Registration/Updates

Any voter registered in Clark County, including those who wish to vote in person instead of by mail, may vote at any Election Day Vote Center within this County. In-person same-day voter registration and updates of existing registration will be offered. New in-person registrants may only vote a provisional ballot. All Election Day Vote Centers also will serve as mail ballot drop-off locations from 7am to 7pm.

Primary Election Early Voting Sites / Mail Ballot Drop-Off Locations May 23 (Saturday) to June 5 (Friday), 2026

All early voting sites are also mail ballot drop-off locations during the listed dates and times.

Unforeseen events or circumstances may cause changes to early voting locations or hours of operation.

For updates, see our website at www.ClarkCountyNV.gov/vote or call (702) 455-VOTE (8683).

Any Clark County registered voter may vote in-person at any Early Voting site or Election Day Vote Center instead of voting by mail.

You may also drop off your voted mail ballot at any Early Voting site or Election Day Vote Center during the specific dates and times in the schedules. See the listing for "Election Department and City Clerk Drop-Off Locations" for other drop-off options. You must sign the outside of your Election Department return envelope, showing your name and address, and seal your voted ballot inside of this envelope before you deposit it in the drop box. *Do not put your ballot in another voter's return envelope.*

If you decide to vote in-person instead of by mail, you will need to do one of the following:

- **If you have your mail ballot**, surrender it in the packet sent to you to an election official at the voting site.
- **If you do not have your mail ballot but had received it in the mail**, you will sign an affirmation at the voting site swearing that you have not already voted in the current election and that you understand no one may attempt to vote or actually vote more than once in the same election.
